

1 Referral

Nalah Centre receives direct referrals from Edmonton Police Services (EPS) Domestic Offender Crime Section

2 Assignment

Files are assigned to one of six caseworkers at Nalah Centre

3 Support

Nalah supports the complainant through docket court. Victim's Rights and Victim of Crime documents are reviewed with each complainant.

4 Services

Services are provided to the complainant via phone/email and include safety plans, docket courtroom orientation, court updates, discussing complainant's wishes, and providing community resources.

5 Case Report Update

A case report update (CRU) is completed with each Nalah client to capture their wishes re: conditions, programming for the AC and court outcome. CRU wishes are then shared in ECC meetings with partners.

6 Early Case Conference (ECC)

ECC meetings happen between Nalah (ECC specialists), Crown, EPS, Probation, Child Services, and defense/duty counsel on each docket day.
